



Frank Clark, 93, passed away February 9, 2015 in San Marcos, Texas. He was born March 31, 1921 in Houston,





### Zesty Sloppy Joes

4 pounds ground beef

1 cup chopped onion

1 cup finely chopped green pepper

2 cans (10-3/4 ounces each) condensed tomato soup, undiluted

1 can (15 ounces) thick and zesty tomato sauce

1 can (8 ounces) tomato sauce

¾ cup packed brown sugar

¼ cup ketchup

3 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce

1 tablespoon prepared mustard

1 tablespoon ground mustard

1 teaspoon chili powder

1 teaspoon garlic salt

20 to 25 hamburger buns



In a large saucepan or Dutch oven, oven, cook beef and onion over medium heat until meat is no longer pink. Add green pepper. Cook and stir for 5 minutes; drain. Add the next 10 ingredients; bring to a boil. Reduce heat; cover and simmer for 1 hour, stirring occasionally. Serve on buns. Yield: 10-25 servings.





Austin Snowfall 2.0 inches on TSD campus February 6, 1967


