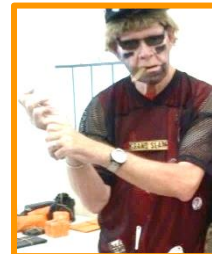

1925-2019

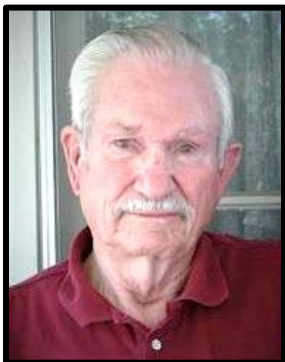

In 1997, DSA's members decided on Deaf Seniors of America (DSA) as the official name of the organization. In 2001, DSA established a quarterly publication, New Horizons. In 2017, we celebrated DSA's 25th anniversary a city away from the site of the first conference, in Houston, Texas. Deaf Seniors of America is a thriving organization committed to ensuring communication access, health, education, and social support for all Deaf and hard-of-hearing senior citizens.
