








What is celebrated on Independence Day?

#### RECIPE

Lady Bird Johnson's Lemon Cake

#### **Ingredients:**

¾ cup softened butter

- 1 ¼ cups sugar
- 8 eggs yolks
- 2 1/2 cups flour
- 3 teaspoons baking powder
- ¼ Teaspoon salt
- 34 cup milk
- 1 Teaspoon Vanilla Extract
- 1 Teaspoon lemon juice
- 1 Teaspoon Grated Lemon Ring

#### Direction:

Preheat your oven to 325 degrees. Cream the butter and sugar until fluffy. In a separate bowl, beat the egg yolks until light and lemon colored. Blend into the creamed mixture. Sift together flour, baking powder and salt; resift 3 times. Add sifted ingredients to creamed mixture in thirds, alternating with milk. Beat the batter thoroughly after each addition. Add vanilla extract, lemon ring and lemon juice, beat 2 minutes. Bake in greased 10-inch Bundt pan in the oven for 1 hour or until the cake tester inserted in the center comes out clean. Remove from the oven and cool 19 minutes before inverting on serving platter.

#### Lemon Glaze:

- 2 cups confectioners' sugar
- 1-2 Tablespoon fresh lemon juice
- 1-2 Teaspoon Buttermilk
- Zest of one fresh lemon
