




graduated from the Texas School for the Deaf in 1950. (No details available).

RECIPE Pace Sunset Dip

Prep/Cook Time: 5 minutes
1 pkg (8 oz) cream cheese, softened
1 cup shedded Cheddar cheese
1 cup Pace Chunky Salsa
