



Glenda Kay (Keeton) Alvarez 1944-2019







COUGHS – rub generously on feet and cover with socks to help minimize coughing.


SORE MUSCLES - rub generously on sore muscles.

RECIPE Mini Sloppy Joe Cups



1 package (12 ounces) refrigerated biscuit Dough (junior-size, 10 biscuits)

1 medium onion, diced (about ½ cup)

1 can (10 ¾ ounces) Campbells Condensed Tomato Soup

34 pound ground beef

2 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce

¾ cup shredded pepper Jack cheese or Cheddar cheese (about 6 ounces)

INGREDIENTS (How to make it)

Step 1 Heat the oven to 350f. Spray (12 (2 ½ inch) muffin-pan cups with vegetable cooking spray.

Step 2 Roll or pat the biscuits to flatten slightly. Press the biscuits into the bottoms and up the sides of the muffins-pan cups.

Step 3 Cook the beef and onion in a 12-inch skillet over medium-high heat until the beef is well browned, stirring often to separated meat. Pour off any fat. Stir in the Worcestershire, soup and cheese and cook until the mixture is hot bubbling stirring occasionally. Spoon the beef mixture into the biscuit cups.

Step 4 Bake for 15 minutes or until the biscuits are golden brown. Let the minis cool in the pan on a wire rack for 5 minutes.
